

Instructions for Accessing and Using NetTutor in Canvas

What is NetTutor

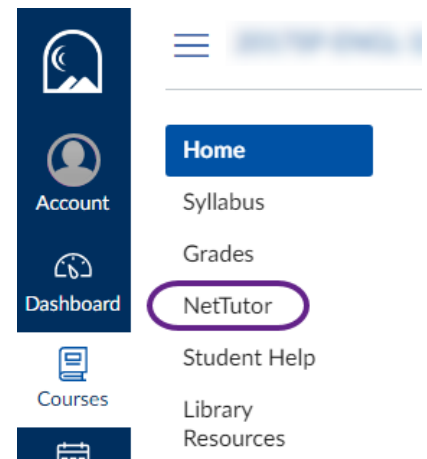
NetTutor provides free, online tutoring for students currently enrolled at Cuyamaca College. Students can access NetTutor through their Canvas course. If the link for NetTutor does not

Finding NetTutor in your course

1. Log into Canvas from the [Cuyamaca College Canvas login page](#)
2. Click one of your courses from the Dashboard
3. Click "NetTutor" on the course menu *

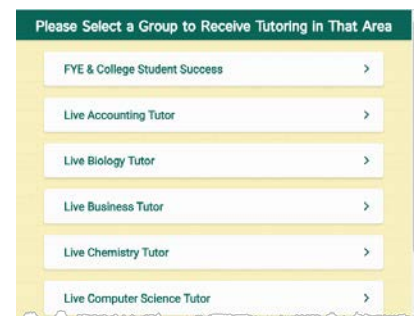
* If you do not see NetTutor on your course menu, ask your instructor to [add it to the menu](#) or access it through the menu of the [CC Student Help Course](#).



Using NetTutor

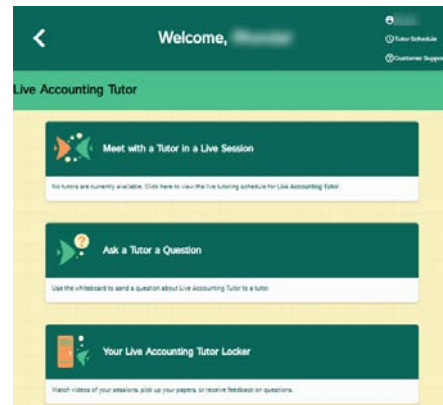
1. A list of subjects should appear. You can choose any of those subjects to start a tutoring session.

After choosing a subject, a list of types of tutoring options will appear:

- **Meet with a Tutor in a Live Session** – This will take you to a live tutor
- **Ask a Tutor a Question** – This will allow you to leave a question with a tutor, then you will receive an answer through an email at a later time
- **Your Live Tutor Locker** – This will allow you to look back at previous sessions you had with NetTutor
- **Drop off Your Paper for Review** – This option comes up if you choose from the topics the “*Online Writing Lab*” topic. Get help with your papers and essays (takes about 48 hours for a review to be returned to you)

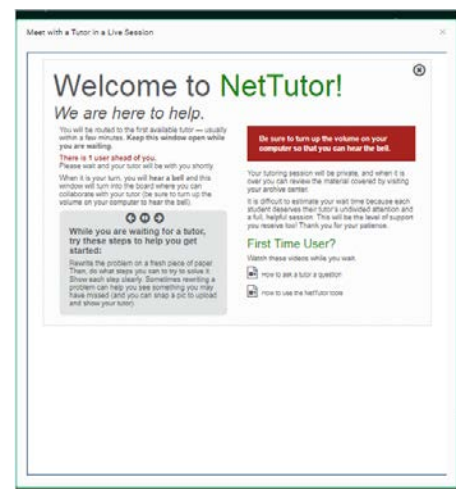

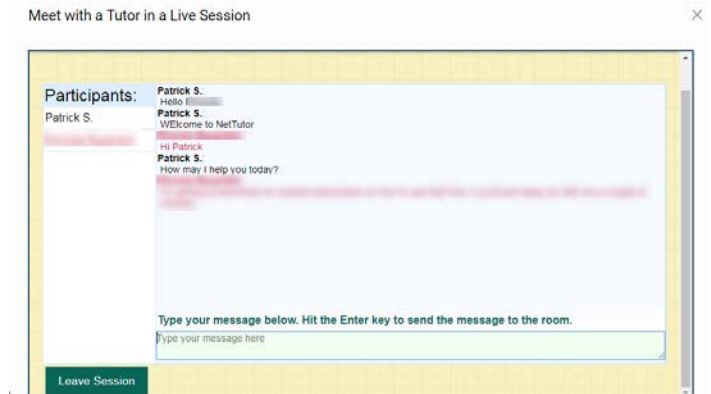
2. After choosing a venue, (in this example: *Meet with a Tutor in a Live Session*) you will see a screen that tells you how many are ahead of you.

You can watch a video on “*How to ask a tutor a question in NetTutor*” while you wait!

A “**cowbell**” sound will ring (and visual bell will display) when they are ready for you.

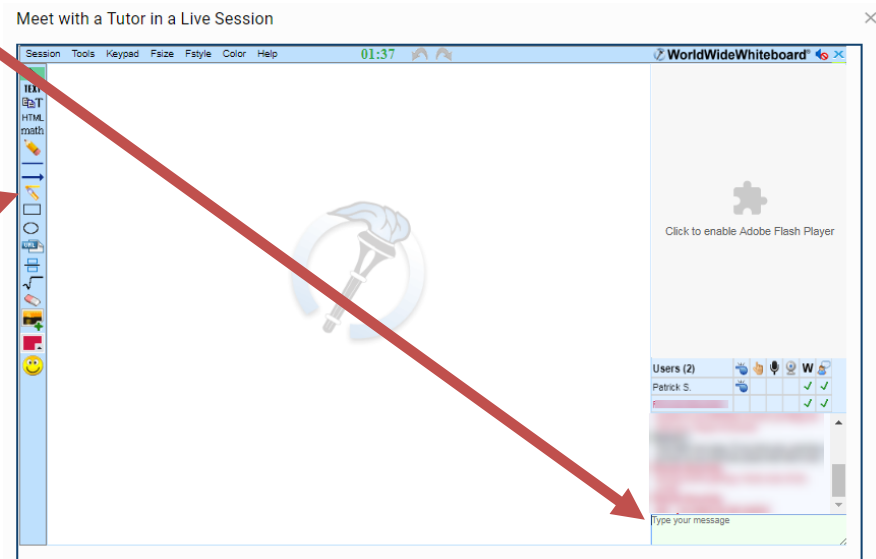


- The Chat window will appear and you may begin your tutoring session.



- Type in the box on the bottom-right corner to chat.

- Use the tools on the left-hand side for a more options



You can save your Session into a PDF document that includes all your “pages” from your whiteboard. Go to the menu bar: **Session > Save as pdf**
