Cuyamaca College's Accreditation Liaison Officer has informed the ACCJC that the College will be offering a new transfer degree: Spanish AA-T. The information provided indicates the degree has been substantially developed from existing College curriculum.

The development of the Spanish AA-T degree is in response to the Student Transfer Reform Act, (SB 1440), which mandates that California Community Colleges (CCC) develop transfer degrees to facilitate the successful transfer of students from the CCC system to the California State University system.
