| New SAT Test (Taken after March 2016) | 550 or above on the Evidenced Based Reading and Writing Section |
| Old SAT Test (Taken before March 2016) | 500 or above on the critical reading section of the old SAT Reasoning Test |
| IB English | 4 or above (Students earn 6.0 units of college credit in area C1) |
| ACT English | 22 or above |
| EPT | 147 or above |

Assessments and courses taken at other institutions

Math and English: Assessment scores (not necessarily placements) are accepted from the Accuplacer assessment test taken at any California Community College.

Students are exempt from the assessment if they have completed a Math or English course at an accredited institution with a "C" or better.
