APPLICATION PERIOD

- Fall Application period opens on August 1, 2017 and is due November 30, 2017

- You must apply online:

- Apply to graduate with AA or AS degree from Cuyamaca College: <http://www.cuyamaca.edu/admissions/forms.asp>

UC MINIMUM TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 60 UC units by end of Spring 2018
- Complete the following course pattern, with a C or better:
 - Two courses in English composition
 - One transferable Math concepts and quantitative reasoning
 - Four transferable college course from at least two of the following areas: arts and humanities, the social and behavior science and the physical and biological science

UCSD UNIVERSITYLINK

- Application must be submitted in first year
- Family income <\$40,000/year
- 3.5 GPA by the end of Fall 2017
- Complete both UC transferable English courses and UC transferable Math course by the end of Fall 2017
- Check **UCSD ULink** box on your UC application!!!

UC TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE

- Check **TAG** box next to the university that you have TAG with on your UC application to indicate that you are a TAG student
- Should have completed TAG application separately in September 2017

PERSONAL INSIGHT QUESTIONS

- Take time to compose it in a word processing application, such as Microsoft Word, then copy and paste it into the appropriate boxes.
- There is one required question you must answer.
- You must also answer 3 out of 7 additional questions.
- Each response is limited to a maximum of 350 words.
- Which three questions you choose to answer are up to you: But you should select questions that are most relevant to your experience and that best reflect your individual circumstances.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Save username and password
- Have a valid email and check frequently
- All insight questions are equal: All questions are given equal consideration in the application review process, which means there is no advantage or disadvantage to choosing certain questions over others.
- There is no right or wrong way to answer these questions. It's about getting to know your personality, background, interests and achievements in your own unique voice.

TRANSCRIPTS

- Final transcripts due July 1, 2018
- Strongly recommended to complete IGETC Certification and submit to UC, if applicable.
- You must request transcripts from each campus you attended.
- AP scores must also be requested
 - www.collegeboard.com
- Submit high school transcripts, if applicable
- Send transcripts directly to campus

APPLICATION STATUS

- You must update your UC application by **January 31, 2018** including your fall grades, through the “Transfer Academic Update”

STUDENT INTENT TO REGISTER

- Turn in by June 1, 2018 with \$100
- Request certification of your IGETC through Admissions & Records to be sent in no later than July 1, 2018.

\$70 FOR EACH CAMPUS

- Fee Waiver
 - UC will waive application fees for up to four campuses for qualified students who would otherwise be unable to apply for admission. The fee waiver program is for United States citizens, permanent residents, and applicants eligible for AB540 benefits.
 - You can apply for a fee waiver within the online application and be notified immediately whether you have qualified. You will need to provide your family's income and the number of people supported by that income.
